
TOWN OF ISLIP CURBSIDE COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS




Household Garbage Recyclables & Yard Waste

All pails and garbage must be placed curbside for collection prior to 6:00a.m. on the scheduled day.

Use one curbside location in front of your home.

Pails must be under 50lbs. with adequate handles and not exceed 40 gallons. Keep pails away from parked vehicles and other obstructions.



<u>KITCHEN GARBAGE:</u> Food and non-recyclable food packaging should be placed in pails with adequate handles or bags placed curbside on either household collection day. Please refer to the "Garbage/Recycling Schedule" of the "How Do I" tab on www.islipny.gov for you collection schedule. Further detailed disposal information can be found in the itemized "Waste Disposal Guide" under the view portion of the "How Do I" tab on www.islipny.gov.

TRASH: Household trash including wood, flooring, tiles, wallboard, carpet, etc. should be placed in pails, securely tied in bundles or bags under 4'x2'x2' and 50lbs. Manure must be double-bagged under 30lbs. A limit of six (6) bags, pails or bundles of household trash will be taken on either household collection day. Concrete, rocks, dirt, asphalt, bricks and other stone are not collected curbside.

<u>YARD WASTE:</u> Leaves, brush, shrubs, and garden plants/flowers must be pailed, bagged or bundled securely less than 50lbs and no longer than 4'x2'x2'. A limit of six (6) items will be taken on either household collection day.

Grass clippings are not accepted curbside at any time.

Unlimited Yard Waste Collections occur in the Spring, Fall & Winter. Please

refer to the "Garbage/Recycling Schedule" of the "How Do I" tab on www.islipny.gov for you collection schedule.

PLEASE DO NOT:

- •Do not use bungee cords or ties on pails lids.
- •Do not place garbage to the curb prior to 4:00p.m. the day before scheduled collections.
- •Do not leave empty pails to the curb longer than 10:00a.m. the day after collection.
- •Do not place grass, chlorine & hazardous materials out to the curb for collection.
- •Do not put out more than the limits or exceed 50lb weight restriction.

WRAP/ RECYCLABLES/ BULK METAL & E-WASTE:

Recyclables are collected every Wednesday on an alternating schedule. Paper/cardboard are collected one week and the next week is metal/glass/plastic. Bulk metals (appliances and metal furniture) and E-Waste (televisions, computers, etc.) are also collected Wednesday. *Please do not use plastic bags*. See the Town's "WRAP Recycling Calendar" under "Community & Services" tab of www.islipny.gov for the alternating schedule.

<u>BULK FURNITURE/ LARGE ITEMS:</u> Items such as a sofa, dining table, cabinets, bookshelves, etc. (non-recyclable metal materials). <u>A limit of 3 items will be taken on the last household collection day</u>. It is not necessary to make an appointment.

ALL COLLECTION SERVICES ARE *CANCELED**ON THE FOLLOWING HOLIDAYS:

New Years Day Labor Day

Memorial Day Thanksgiving Day Independence Day Christmas Day

*THERE IS NO SUBSTITUTE COLLECTION. Pails should not be placed to the curb until the evening before the next regularly scheduled collection day.
