TOWN OF ISLIP BLACK PAIL DISTRICT CURBSIDE COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS



All pails and garbage must be placed curbside for collection prior to 6:00a.m. on the scheduled day. Black pails are for kitchen garbage only.

Use one curbside location in front of your home.

Keep pails at least 4' away from parked vehicles, utility poles and other obstructions. All privately owned pails must be under 50lbs. with adequate handles and not exceed 40 gallons.



<u>KITCHEN GARBAGE:</u> Food and non-recyclable food packaging should be put in the black pail curbside on either household collection day. Do not put any other type of waste in the black pail. Kitchen waste that does not fit in the black pail can be bagged or pailed under 50lbs. and put out on your second collection day of the week. Please refer to the "Garbage/Recycling Schedule" of the "How Do I" tab on www.islipny.gov for you collection schedule. Further detailed disposal information can be found in the itemized "Waste Disposal Guide" under the view portion of the "How Do I" tab on www.islipny.gov.

<u>WRAP/RECYCLABLES/BULK METAL & E-WASTE</u>: Recyclables are collected every Wednesday on an alternating schedule. Paper/cardboard are collected one week and the next week is metal/glass/plastic. Bulk metals (appliances and metal furniture) and E-Waste (televisions, computers, etc.) are also collected every Wednesday. *Please do <u>not</u> use plastic bags*. See the Town's "WRAP Recycling Calendar" under "Community & Services" tab on www.islipny.gov for the alternating schedule.

<u>YARD WASTE:</u> Leaves, brush, shrubs, and garden plants/flowers must be pailed, bagged or bundled securely less than 50lbs and no longer than 4'x2'x2'. <u>A limit of twelve (12) items will be taken on the first garbage collection day of the week</u>. *Grass clippings are <u>not</u> accepted curbside at any time*. Unlimited Yard Waste Collections occur in the Spring, Fall & Winter. Please refer to the "Garbage/Recycling Schedule" of the "How Do I" tab on www.islipny.gov for you collection schedule.

TRASH: Items including overflow kitchen garbage, wood, flooring, tiles, wallboard and carpeting must be bagged, pailed or securely bundled less than 50lbs. and no longer than $4x^2x^2$. Latex paint must be fully dried and double bagged. <u>A limit of twelve (12) bags, pails or bundles of household trash will be taken on the last household collection day of the week</u>.

BULK FURNATURE/LARGE ITEMS: Items such as sofa, dining table, cabinets & bookshelves (non-recyclable metal). <u>A limit of 3 items will be taken on the last regular collection day</u>. It is not necessary to make an appointment.
