PUBLIC NOTICE

Request for Written Comments on Proposed Shellfish Aquaculture Lease Site Relocation

Notice is hereby given that the Suffolk County Department of Economic Development and Planning has received an application from an existing Leaseholder, requesting to relocate from its 10-acre shellfish aquaculture lease site in Great Peconic Bay to a 10-acre lease site Little Peconic Bay. Pursuant to Local Law 25-2009, *A Local Law Establishing the Suffolk County Shellfish Aquaculture Lease Program in Peconic Bay and Gardiners Bay* (Article II of the Suffolk County Code, §475), leaseholders may request the relocation of their leasehold interest for any reason up to two times during the term of the lease. Please note that while this leaseholder has selected and applied for two potential relocation sites, following the site approval process, they will be selecting only one site for relocation. Having already received a lease under a Lease Application Cycle #3, this relocation will not impact on the Annual Acreage Cap.

The proposed lease site(s) are located within the adopted Shellfish Cultivation Zone and are available for lease. Pertinent data and information about the Lease Site Relocation Application, including the name of the leaseholder, SCALP reference #, and the proposed lease site(s) are contained in the table below.

Documentation supporting the claim should also be provided, including a copy of the parties' commercial harvest license, and documentation on harvests and sales, as applicable.

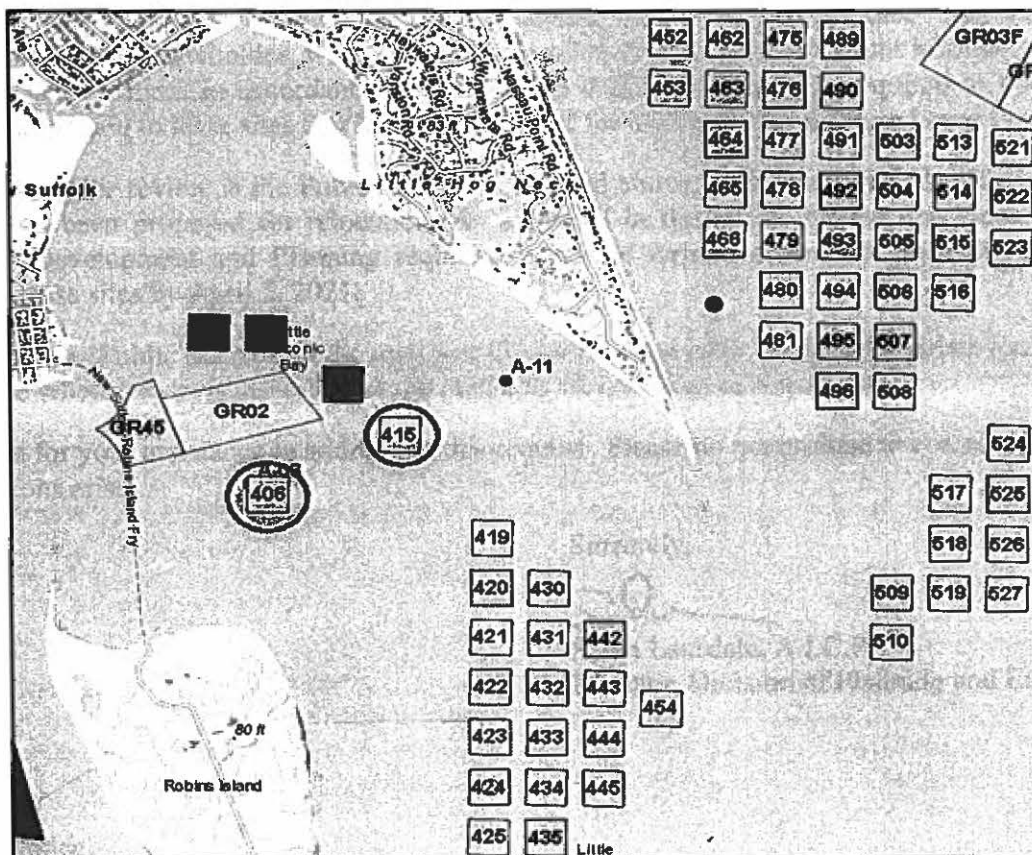
