PETS

- • Proper ID and rabies tags
- Carrier or cage
- Leash
- Ample food supply (at least two weeks)
- Water/food bowls
- Medications
- Specific care instructions
- Newspaper, cat litter, scoop, plastic bags for handling waste
- Proper ID on all belongings
- Manual can opener
- Updated shots within past 12 months

Also, be sure to check whether the shelter you are heading to is pet-friendly. If it is not, you will need to either find a shelter that is or an alternative.
