- 1 Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 1 of chapter 397 of the laws of
- 2 1996, relating to authorizing the town of Islip to lease certain lands
- 3 to a business corporation, as amended by chapter 303 of the laws of
- 4 2012, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) The town of Islip, in the county of Suffolk, is hereby authorized
- 6 and empowered to extend the terms of a lease between the town and a
- 7 business corporation dated July 30, 1996 that was authorized by chapter
- 8 397 of the laws of 1996 on the lands described in chapter 397 of the
- 9 laws of 1996 for up to [ten] twenty-six additional years from the date
- 10 of its expiration.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
