

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE ANNUAL ELECTION OF THE WEST ISLIP FIRE DISTRICT WILL BE HELD ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 9, 2025 BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 2:00 PM AND 9:00 PM AT THE FIREHOUSE WITHIN THE DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

All qualified voters residing within said Fire District shall vote at the Fire Headquarters Building located at 309 Union Boulevard (near Higbie Lane), West Islip, New York. This election will be for the purpose of electing one (1) Fire Commissioner of said Fire District for a five (5) year term, commencing on January 1, 2026 and ending December 31, 2030; and one (1) Fire Commissioner of said Fire District for a one (1) year term, commencing on January 1, 2026 and ending December 31, 2026. All candidates for the office of Fire Commissioner shall file their names in petition form, subscribed to by at least twenty-five (25) qualified voters of the Fire District, with the Secretary of the West Islip Fire District, at the Fire Headquarters Building, 309 Union Boulevard, West Islip, New York, at least twenty (20) days prior to December 9, 2025. In 2025, petitions must be filed by November 19, 2025 between the hours of 9:00am and 3:00pm. Petitions may be obtained from the Fire District Secretary at the Fire Headquarters Building located at 309 Union Boulevard, West Islip, New York, between the hours of 9:00am and 3:00pm, Monday through Friday.

THOSE QUALIFIED TO VOTE:

Every elector who shall be a registered voter and who shall have resided in the West Islip Fire District for a period of thirty (30) days next preceding this election. Only those persons who have registered with the County Board of Election on or before the 23rd day before the Fire District Election day shall be eligible to vote. In 2025, such registration must take place on or before November 17, 2025.

PREPARATION OF REGISTRATION ROLLS: the Board of Elections of the West Islip Fire District shall meet on December 9, 2025 from the hours of 1:00pm and 2:00pm at the West Islip Firehouse at 309 Union Boulevard, West Islip, New York, for the purposes of preparing the rolls of registered voters of the West Islip Fire District.

CANDIDATES: Each candidate for the office of Fire Commissioner must be, at the time of the election and throughout his/her term in office, a resident of the West Islip Fire District.
