PROPERTY OWNER ANNUAL COST

- + The new sewers will be provided by Suffolk County and the cost recovered by assessment of a debt component at the rate of \$14 per \$1000 of Assessed Valuation and is based on present land use/assessed value.
- Additionally, there will be a sewer use fee based on property type for the treatment at the County's Southwest Sewer District's treatment facility.
