Re: Proposed Extension of Suffolk County Sewer District #3 (Southwest) to Provide Sewer Service to Carleton Avenue, Central Islip from Suffolk Avenue to Smith Street

Dear Property Owner:

You are receiving this letter because our records indicate that you are the Owner of the property in the above referenced sewer extension area. When the Project is completed, you will have the ability to connect to the proposed sewer system, thereby relieving you of certain limitations on the use of your property contained in the Suffolk County Sanitary Code and possibly, enhancing your property value.

In order for the engineers to better understand how to connect the referenced property to the proposed sewer system, the County and Town are requesting permission to schedule an engineer's site visit to the property to confirm the location of the existing sanitary disposal system that serves the property. This brief site visit will be conducted during normal business hours and at the convenience of the property owner.

Public health COVID concerns will limit the number of people and provide for an exterior inspection only. An engineer will then contact you to arrange a day and time for the inspection.
