WHEREAS, the Town of Islip ("the Town") owns and operates Long Island MacArthur Airport ("the Airport"), a FAA Part 139 certificated airport with over one (1) million passengers each year; and

WHEREAS, Hyannis Air Service Inc., operating as Cape Air ("Airline"), is a corporation primarily engaged in the business of air transportation with respect to the carriage of persons, property, cargo and mail; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Islip Department of Aviation and Transportation recommends entering into an Airline Use and Lease Agreement with Hyannis Air Service Inc for a period of one (1) year with four (4) one (1) year options and fees that are consistent and set by the Airport's Signatory Rates with annual rent increases for rates and charges: and

WHEREAS, the Town of Islip held a public hearing on July 15, 2025, at 2:00 p.m. (EST) to hear all matters relating to the Hyannis Air Service Inc. Airline Use and Lease Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion of Councilperson _____, seconded by Councilperson _____; be it

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor is hereby authorized to execute an Airline Use and Lease Agreement with Hyannis Air Service Inc. for a period of one (1) year with a renewal option for an additional four (4) one (1) year options with fees that are consistent and set by the Airport's rates and charges.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Islip enacted Chapter 50A of the Town of Islip Town Code to provide the Office of the Town Board with powers as shall be necessary for the proper administration of the Department consistent with applicable provisions of law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Town Law § 53 and Municipal Home Rule Law, the Town Board is authorized to reorganize, consolidate, or transfer functions among departments, agencies, or administrative units of the Town by local law; and

WHEREAS, the Public Information Office (“PIO”) currently functions under the direction of the Office of the Supervisor and performs duties integral to external communication, media relations, and public engagement on behalf of the Town; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Town and its residents to reorganize and transfer the Public Information Office to operate under the jurisdiction of the Office of the Town Board; and

WHEREAS, this proposed reorganization constitutes a transfer of powers customarily exercised by the Town Supervisor, an elected official, to the Town Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law § 23(2)(f), a local law that transfers powers from an elected official is subject to a mandatory referendum; and

WHEREAS, certain amendments to Chapter 50A of the Islip Town Code are necessary to reflect this transfer and implement the proposed reorganization; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed amendments was duly held on July 15, 2025.

CHAPTER 50A – OFFICE OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF ISLIP

§50A-4 General powers and duties.

A. The members of the Town Board shall exercise and maintain such powers as shall be necessary for the administration of the Office consistent with applicable provisions of law or procedures pertinent thereto, including but not limited to legislative powers.

B. Divisions:

(1) PUBLIC INFORMATION OFFICE

This Office shall provide residents with Town information through the use of media, newsletters, publications and the Town website. This Division shall be responsible for channeling all public information and news in all media from and to the Town Board and Supervisor. The Public Information Office shall generally perform such other public information duties in the service of the Town Board and Supervisor as may be directed respectively thereby.
