The Uniform Traffic Code of the Town of Islip has been amended
Upon a vote being taken the result was

WHEREAS, in or around 2008, the Town Board of the Town of Islip (the "Town") granted a nonexclusive franchise to install, maintain, extend, and operate a cable system in the Town (the "Franchise") to Cablevision Systems Islip Corporation ("Franchisee"), for a period of ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, the Franchisee's successors in interest, Altice USA, Inc. and Samson Cablevision Corporation, LLC, a corporation and limited liability company duly organized under the applicable laws of the State of New York, were granted approval to enter into a Franchise within the Town on the September 16, 2025 Town Board Meeting; and; and

WHEREAS, the Franchisee, which continues to provide services to the Town also seeks to renew the Franchise within the Town;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Town Law § 64(7), the Town Board is authorized to grant rights, franchises, permissions or consents for the use of the streets, highways, and public places or any part thereof or the space above or under them or any of them, for any specific purpose authorized by law upon such terms and conditions as it may deem proper and as may be permitted by law; and

WHEREAS, the Town wishes to renew the Franchise for a period of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk has placed a Public Notice in the newspaper circulated locally which indicates the nature of the proposed renewal.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held therefor on November 18, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of _____, seconded by _____, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board authorizes the Supervisor to execute a Franchise Renewal Agreement with Cablevision Systems Islip Corporation for a period of five (5) years to install, maintain, extend, and operate a cable system in the Town of Islip, as set forth in the attached document:

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Islip (the "Town"), has heretofore established the Bay Shore Fire Protection District pursuant to Town Law § 184; and

WHEREAS, the Bay Shore Fire District (the "Fire District"), a political subdivision of the State of New York duly organized pursuant to Town Law §§ 170–189, currently provides fire protection services to the Bay Shore Fire Protection District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 17-A of the General Municipal Law, the Town Board and the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Fire District have jointly prepared a proposed Joint Consolidation and Dissolution Agreement for the consolidation of the Bay Shore Fire Protection District and the Bay Shore Fire District into a single fire district and dissolve the Bay Shore Fire Protection District; and

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of November, 2025, a duly noticed public hearing was held by the Town Board concerning the proposed Joint Consolidation and Dissolution Agreement, at which all interested persons were heard; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the Town Board finds it in the public interest to approve said Joint Consolidation and Dissolution Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion of Councilperson _____, seconded by Councilperson _____, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Islip hereby approves, and authorizes the Supervisor to execute, the Joint Consolidation and Dissolution Agreement between the Bay Shore Fire Protection District and the Bay Shore Fire District.
