I hope this letter finds you well. As we get through our winter months, I would like to share some long-awaited ...almost 50 years to be exact...exciting updates coming to the Byron Lake Park facility this Summer!

Starting the week of February 6th, you will begin to notice that our contractor will commence mobilizing materials and machinery to start the process of the long-anticipated lake rehabilitation. Improvements to the lake will include replacing all of the bulkheading around the lake, and the island, installing a new weir to improve water flow, and repairing the culvert to the west of the lake. Work will be taking place Monday through Friday 7:00am-4:00pm, with every effort made to have a minimal impact on the surrounding area and its residents.

The other exciting part of this project is the brand-new swimming pool, along with the surrounding pool buildings. The pool work kicked-off in September, and our contractors have been hard at work to do our very best to bring your pool back to you this season. Please bare in mind, the Town, like every other entity in our new complicated world, anticipates supply chain issues and other circumstances that may affect our timeline.

Work will be continuing through the Spring, and the nature of these projects may make it necessary for the park to be closed at times for safety reasons.

We thank you for your patience and understanding while we work hard to ensure that once this project is complete, Byron Lake Park will be a gem of our Town that will create lasting memories for years to come.
