Under supervision, an Automotive Mechanic III is a journeyman mechanic engaged in diagnosing malfunctions of automotive vehicles and auxiliary equipment and repairing or replacing parts as necessary. The employee uses independent judgment in carrying out assignments after receiving work orders and is responsible for testing results after completion. The employee may supervise lower level Automotive Mechanics. Performs related work as required. Employee may diagnose mechanical and electrical problems, rebuilds engines and transmissions, rewires generators, repairs power brakes and power steering. Employee may also repair auxiliary equipment used with automotive vehicles such as plows & mowers.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Either: a) Completion of two (2) years in a vocational school program, or in an apprentice or training program in one of the craft areas and two (2) years of experience in the craft; or, b) Four (4) years of experience in the repair of mechanical systems; or, c) A satisfactory equivalent combination of the above education or training and experience as defined by the limits of (a) and (b); or, d) Two (2) years of experience as an Automotive Mechanic II.
